



SEASIDE BLANKET



“The colours for this Seaside Blanket were inspired by a collection of pebbles, seashells and seaglass which i’ve gathered during holidays in Cornwall, Devon and the Gower Peninsula. I loved how they came together, with the various tones giving a wonderful refreshing colour palette”

You will need:

Stylecraft Special DK yarn in Parchment, Empire, Sherbert, Storm, Pistachio, Sage and Azure.

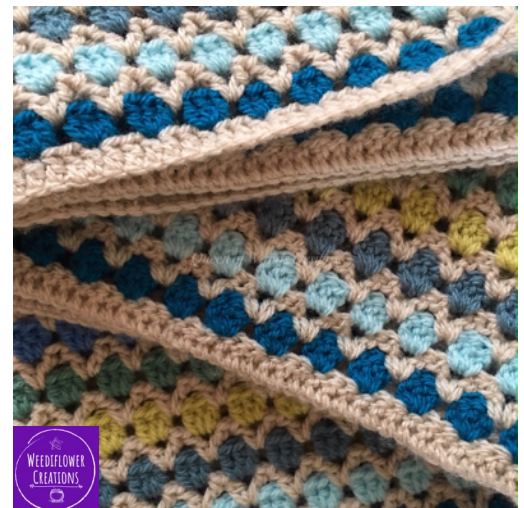
4 mm hook for the blanket and 4.5 mm hook for the foundation row (optional - see tip below).

Tip: *When working the chain foundation row, be sure not to make the chains too tight. Another way around this is to use a hook the next size up (4.5 mm) for the foundation row only.*

UK Crochet Terms used in this pattern:

Ch = Chain

Tr = Treble





Sizes:

Blanket approximately 190cm wide suitable for a King and Superking sized bed
Foundation row Ch 319.

Blanket approximately 150cm wide suitable for a Double bed
Foundation row Ch 280

Blanket approximately 110cm wide suitable for a Single bed
Foundation row Ch 238

Row 1: Using *Parchment* yarn, Ch 319/280/238 depending on size of blanket, turn.

Row 2: Tr1 into 4th chain from hook, tr1 into each chain, turn.

Row 3: Joining *Coloured* yarn, ch3 then tr1 into first space, * skip two spaces tr3 into next space*, repeat * to * to end of row until three spaces remain, skip two spaces tr2 into last space, tie off yarn, turn.

Row 4: Using *Parchment* yarn, ch3, tr1 ch1 tr1 into space, *tr1 ch1 tr1 into space * repeat * to * to end of row, tr1 into space between the tr2 of previous round, turn.

Row 5: Joining *Coloured* yarn, Ch3, tr3 into first large space between the first V, *tr3 into the next large space between the V*, repeat * to * to end of row, tr1 into the end space, turn.

Row 6: Using *Parchment* yarn, Ch3 tr1 into the space immediately next to it, *tr1 ch1 tr1 into the space between two groups of tr3's of previous row*, repeat * to * to end, tr2 into last space, turn.

Row 7: Joining *Coloured* yarn, Ch3, tr1 into the space immediately next to it, tr3 into first large space between the first V, *tr3 into the next large space between the V*, repeat * to * to end of row, tr2 into the end space, turn.

Repeat rows 4 to 7 for the desired length of the blanket, remembering to work the rows between those worked in *Parchment* yarn with the following *Coloured* yarns to complete the colour palette:

Empire, Sherbert, Storm, Pistachio, Sage and Azure.

Note: Before you make the final row given below, ensure you finish with a Row 7 in *Coloured* yarn.



Final row: Using *Parchment* yarn, Ch3, skip first stitch, tr1 into each stitch, tie off. *If you are unsure what is meant by each stitch, take a look at the top of the row you have just worked, you will see it looks like a row of chain stitches. You will be working your final row by pushing your crochet hook through the small space beneath each of the chain stitches.*
