



'BRIGHT STAR' (FOR XANDRA)



“A sweet and quick-to-make little crochet star created specially for my brilliant sister-in-law Xandra; because she asked if I had a pattern for a star so I made one for her.”

You will need:

Double Knit yarn or cotton of your choice,
3.5 mm crochet hook.

UK Crochet Terms used in this pattern:

Ch = Chain

Tr or tr = Treble

SS or ss = Slip Stitch



To Make:

Round 1: Ch5, join with ss into first ch.

Round 2: Ch3 (counts as first tr) tr2 into ring, *ch1 tr3 into ring* and repeat * to * three times, ch1 and ss into top of first tr. You should have five clusters and five spaces.

Round 3: SS across top of first cluster and into first space, ch3 (counts as first tr) tr2 ch1 tr 3 into this first space, *tr3 ch1 tr 3* into each of the next four spaces, ss into top of first tr.

Round 4: SS across top of first cluster and into first space, ch3 (counts as first tr) tr2 ch3 tr 3 into this first space, *ss into top of first tr of next set of clusters, tr3 ch3 tr 3 into next space, repeat * to* three times, ss into top of first tr of next set of clusters, ss into top of first tr of round to complete.

Tie off and weave tails in.

Dampen the stars and arrange flat on a blocking mat or towel placed on your bed. Pin the tips of each star at the ch3 spaces by pushing the pin downwards into the mat or towel so that the stars dry with a nice pointed end. NOTE: It's best to use pearl/ bead-headed pins so you they are easy to remove. If you need the stars to be stiff this can be achieved with a spray starch.

Project ideas:

The Brilliant Star motif is perfect to make as individual tree decorations, an embellishment on a wrapped gift or strung together to create a festive garland.

Whatever you make I wish you lots of magical creations and enjoyment.
